A Statement of Boarding Principles

Boarding at Durham School aims to provide a safe, supportive, challenging and stimulating environment in which boarders can thrive and be happy. Boarding is overseen by the Deputy Head [Staff], Senior Housemasters/mistresses, boarding staff, resident tutors and ancillary staff according to the School's policies and procedures. Boarders and parents/guardians of boarders are encouraged to maintain regular contact with boarding staff and report any concerns promptly and without fear to an appropriate member of staff. Boarders' views are sought via House and School Councils to identify areas of concern and opportunities for development in order continuously to evaluate and improve the range and quality of boarding provision.
